a) Tuition

A discount applies to tuition fees for families with more than one student enrolled at the school at the same time: - Second child - 5%
Third child - 25%
Fourth child or over - 50%

Fees are due and payable at the end of the first week of each term. Fees are invoiced four times a year except for Year 12 where they are invoiced over the first three terms in the year. A final account is issued to parents in December for any incidentals during term four.

A late fee of \$120 may be added to accounts where fees are overdue and no arrangement for payment has been made with the Business Office.

Year Levies

All known compulsory incidental charges applicable to a whole year group in 2019 have been incorporated into a year levy and the costs spread over the year. This allows for more certainty over the cost of the student's education and assists families with budgeting. Items covered by this levy include accident insurance, school magazine and diary, transport and entrance fees for sport, compulsory testing fees such as NAPLAN, subject costs for students in Years 7 and 8 and planned excursions and additional programmes involving a whole year. The levy includes all planned events for 2019. This levy is non-refundable and credits will not be issued from failure to participate in these compulsory activities.

There may be occasions where an opportunity arises for an additional excursion and this amount will be charged separately on the family fee account.

d) Co-Curricular Music

Students choosing to participate in the co-curricular music program will be charged a fee of \$110 per term.

Individual instrument tuition is available in the School and details of fees are given on request. Payment of fees is an arrangement between the tutor and family involved.

e) LearningField Levy

Northholm will use Champion for the supply of textbooks and resources for Years K – 6, 11 & 12, and for additional booklets such as student workbooks, art diaries etc. for Years 7 – 10.

Students in Years 7 – 10 will have their textbooks delivered electronically via the Learning Field application. This levy will be charged in Term 1 or on enrolment.

f) Capital Levy

A fee of \$300 per family per term is charged and funds raised go towards building and grounds improvements.

g) Enrolment Application Fees

h) Enrolment Deposit

When enrolment is offered and accepted by the family, a deposit of \$1,500 is required. If the student does not take up the confirmed position, the deposit is not refundable. The deposit is refunded when the student leaves the school provided that there are no outstanding fees and adequate notice in writing of withdrawal has been received.

i) Capital Enrolment Fee

A sum of \$1,500 is payable for each new student entering the School. This fee is due on confirmation of enrolment and is non-refundable. These amounts contribute to the building of new facilities at the School.

j) Voluntary Building Fund Donation

Parents are invited to make voluntary contributions to the Building Fund and these contributions are tax deductible. A receipt for tax purposes will be issued in June of each year. The suggested amount of a minimum of \$150 per family will appear on each statement. Amounts donated to the Building Fund are used for new buildings and major refurbishments.

k) Student Accident Insurance

All students enrolled at Northholm are covered by an accident insurance policy and details are available on the website. Please contact the Business Office if you require a claim form.

l) The Northholm Association Levy

All parents are eligible for membership of the Northholm Association and the amount of \$75 per family will be charged to the account in Term 2.

2019 MONTHLY DIRECT DEBIT OPTION

The School has a system of monthly direct debits for the payment of fees. The advantage of such a system is that payments are spread evenly throughout the year, thus minimising the financial burden at the start of each term. You will need to provide the School with an authority to draw one tenth of the annual fees for your family from a nominated bank account each month. These regular payments will commence in February and conclude in November each year. Any balance remaining on the account as a result of additional co-curricular charges will be debited on the 15 December.

A fee of \$50 will be charged for each monthly direct debit rejected by the bank to cover administration costs.

If you are already participating in the direct debit system and have students enrolled for 2019 the arrangements will be extended automatically.
